

PASSION FOR SUSTAINABILITY

At the start of the academic year, HeadStart embarked on a new initiative to coordinate the long standing work of the school community in areas of Sustainable Practice: HeadStart Eco-School. In our first year we have sought to establish structures and systems which will enable our Sustainable Practices to be self-sustaining, driven by our students. Across the school, we have established 4 student-led Eco-Committees directly involving 40 students from Early Years to Year 13. We have implemented a range of campaigns and practices across the school including systematic waste paper collection and recycling, plastic collection and repurposing, eco-brick 'manufacturing' to help create an Early Years Learning Garden, a clean classroom air campaign and a Friday Changemaker Programme to raise awareness of local-global issues. In addition, we have revitalised our monthly Beach Cleans which have grown in strength with greater community involvement and with a more sustainable approach to the collection of rubbish itself. Raising wider community awareness has also been a strong part of our efforts epitomised by regular updates on our work and actions that parents can implement at home to help make Phuket more sustainable.

We look forward to continuing our work next academic year, helping our community recognise and engage in increasingly more Sustainable Practices.







Tangtoh offers a medium roasted coffee beans with a special flavor of pecan and caramel using a washed process. Also, Tangtoh coffee beans are roasted by one of the best roasters in Thailand. Tangtoh Restaurant opens everyday from 10.00am to 09.00pm. However, the reservation of the table for more than 4 people is recommended at the busy hours such as 'Lunch' and 'Dinner' times. Tangtoh Restaurant & Café is the white building stands out from afar connected to the main road, which is easy to spot and recognize for the re-visiting.



The popular dishes at Tangtoh are all southern dishes; sour Seabass soup, soft Crab with chilli and garlics, and stir-fried crabmeat with yellow chilli. 
Preparation for Adult Life Beyond HeadStart

At HeadStart, Sixth Form initiatives effectively prepare students for university life. Key programs include the Apprentice Competition, where Year 12 students develop job application skills by creating CVs and practising interview techniques, enhancing their presentation to potential universities and employers. The Ready, Steady, Cook program teaches Year 13 students budget-friendly cooking, focusing on meal planning and financial management, essential for independent living. Regular events like the University Fair and Careers Fair 'Next Steps' provide opportunities to engage with university representatives and industry experts, aiding informed decision-making about future studies and careers. Year 12 students also benefit from the Communication Skills program, improving public speaking through the Talking Heads event, and the Science of Learning course, which introduces neuroscience-based study techniques. Bi-weekly Personal, Social, Health, and Economic (PSHE) education,

paired with Social Emotional Learning (SEL), fosters emotional intelligence, resilience, and interpersonal skills. The Extended Project Qualification (EPQ) offers an independent research project alongside A-levels, enhancing academic writing and independent study skills. Students have achieved high grades in this program, demonstrating its effectiveness in preparing them for academic and life challenges beyond school.






