

So, the 10 students were invited to partake in the Phang Nga Conservancy Beach Clean up held in December last year. Little did we know that we would travel on our very own catamaran all the way to Ao Mon beach on the Island of Koh Yao Yai. We had a blast and we, along with several other international and Thai government schools, collected hordes of trash. It was indeed a day of little miracles!

I know we can do better at recycling and we will do better next year. Thank you everyone, particularly year 5B students for giving up so many open lessons and lunchtimes, to help me recycle. I love you all and I am so proud of you!
