Academic Year 2018/19 has been yet another wonderful year of sporting endeavours for our student athletes; both in the classroom as well as all of our extra curricular activities, such as ASP's and sporting fixtures and also all of the events organised through PISAC (Phuket International Schools Athletics Conference). I was delighted to initiate the girls' football programme this year, which has continued to thrive, and I am hopeful they will obtain 'Academy' status next year. Our Volleyball team has also been a new addition this year, and the boys' Basketball continues to expand by offering the same amount of practice sessions and matches as the girls. All-in-all, sports provision at HeadStart continues to progress, grow, and thrive. Some notable performances from this year have been - Under 9 Boys Football team winning the much coveted

British International School's Soccer 7's tournament; the Senior Volleyball team winning the PISAC Tournament (scoring the maximum points possible); a massive team of students (from Primary and Secondary) competing at the PISAC Swimming, Cross-country and Athletics events; the Girls Basketball team won the heavily-contested HeadStart Invitational Cup; Swimming and Football Academy trips to Bangkok, and the Swim team also had their first ever International Swim meet in Malaysia, breaking 27 school records. 














MATHS & COMMERCE FACULTY

What a successful week we had celebrating Mathematics and Commerce week.




















































ENGLISH & HUMANITIES FACULTY







WORLD SCHOLARS CUP

Our top students, all of whom achieved many Grade A or A*s across all their results, were:



This year brings me to the end of my fifth year at HeadStart and throughout that time I have seen many changes and significant expansion, both in terms of student numbers and also physical resources. With these changes came significant improvements to a number of our facilities. Science, Art and Music now have much larger, vibrant and inspiring teaching spaces give our team the tools they need to inspire our students. The significantly expanded Café has given our parents a place to relax after their morning work-out or while waiting to collect their children. The expansion has truly benefited all members of the HeadStart community regardless of the year group they are in, the subjects they study or their interests outside of the core curriculum.

As a school that wishes to minimise its impact on the environment, the installation of one of the biggest solar arrays in the south of Thailand has also benefited the school significantly and will help us to reduce our carbon footprint. The school is now able to produce approximately 500kW of power and provide 85% of the school's energy needs.

In spite of all this expansion and continued growth, examination results and outcomes for students at all levels continue to be excellent with further improvements both at IGCSE and AS level this year with 6 of our students recognised by Cambridge for achieving the highest marks in the whole of Thailand. Our overall grades were the best in the school's history for the second year in succession with further improvements in the number of students receiving the top grades in IGCSEs and AS Levels. I wish all our students well and the best of success, I am sure their hard work and dedication will be rewarded.

This year, we will see the largest group of students graduating HeadStart and concluding their A Level studies. Most have already received offers at prestigious universities throughout the world. Whatever path our students take, I hope that the experience and skills they have learned here will set them up well for the future and that they will be successful in their future careers knowing that wherever they are, they will always be part of the HeadStart community.

As a school we are of course more than just an academic institution, and there is so much more that goes on. Our sporting teams continue to have success in Phuket and throughout Thailand. This year we have also seen significant improvement and expansion in volleyball and basketball and girls football where our teams are developing well and achieving great results against other schools and teams.

In the creative and performing arts department, we have once again seen some excellent performances by our gifted and talented students within the CAPA academy and within the dance programme. I have been fortunate to watch performances by some of our younger students in their 'Around the World' production, some of the older students in the 'Night at the Movies' show, as well as witnessing another amazing night by our dance and CAPA students in the recent end of year dance recital. Finally, it leaves me to say, that none of the above would have been possible without the dedication of our highly qualified and inspired teachers and coaches or the support that you the parents give to both the school and your children on a daily basis. I have said this many times, but one of the greatest assets of HeadStart is the community body that has come together to ensure that the successes above are now common place in the school. Whether your child is academically gifted, whether they are a keen sportsperson, whether they volunteer and support the many school events, or whether they have artistic flair or performing talent, I would like to thank them and you for your contribution to HeadStart this academic year, I hope you all will continue to be inspired by the things we have and do here, and I wish you all a restful and relaxing summer vacation. I look forward to welcoming you back on the 23rd of August at the parent orientation and hope the next 5 years will be as successful as the last.























SWIMMING ACADEMY
